## BRITISH COLUMBIA

B.C. co-ordinator Donna Choo has organized league play in the lower Mainland and on Vancouver Island.

## ALBERTA

Ten leagues are in play throughout Alberta organized by Provincial co-ordinator Chris Zarski, who operates from Clear Vista School in Wetaskiwin, Alberta.

Alberta League games should be completed by March 12, 2012.

Alberta Provincial Finals will take place in April.

## MANITOBA

Provincial co-ordinator John Martens has five leagues and an intermediate tournament playing in Manitoba.

## SASKATCHEWAN

## QUEBEC

## ONTARIO

All Ontario leagues must have a winner by April 2nd, 2012.

The Ontario Playoffs are scheduled for Toronto, **May 12-14, 2012.**

A team may bring up to ten participants (players & coaches) to the Ontario Provincials.
